Conjunctions by Types

1) Coordinating Conjunctions

The short and simple transitions (two or three letters). Use a comma and one of followings (**FANBOYS** - **F**or, **A**nd, **N**or, **B**ut, **O**r, **Y**et, **S**o) to show the way your ideas are related to each other, to avoid short, choppy sentences, and to correct grammatical errors such as run-on sentences.
