สำนักงานเขตพื้นที่การศึกษาประถมศึกษาร้อยเอ็ด เขต 3 ได้จัดทำแบบฝึกทักษะ ภาษาอังกฤษ (Daily English Practice Worksheets) ขึ้น มีวัตถุประสงค์เพื่อพัฒนาทักษะ พื้นฐานในการเรียนภาษาอังกฤษ ยกระดับผลสัมฤทธิ์ทางการเรียนภาษาอังกฤษ และสร้าง โอกาสการเข้าถึงการเรียนรู้ของผู้เรียนอย่างทั่วถึงโดยให้โรงเรียนในสังกัดทุกแห่งนำไปใช้ ในการจัดกิจกรรมเสริมนอกเวลาเรียนทุกวัน

- 1. แบบฝึกทักษะภาษาอังกฤษ (Daily English Practice Worksheets) มีทั้งหมด 6 ชุด ชุดละ 200 ฉบับ มีความเหมาะสมกับนักเรียนในแต่ละระดับชั้น ดังนี้
 - ❖ Level 1 (P1-001 ถึง P1-200) สำหรับนักเรียนชั้นประถมศึกษาปีที่ 1
 - ❖ Level 2 (P2-001 ถึง P2-200) สำหรับนักเรียนชั้นประถมศึกษาปีที่ 2
 - ❖ Level 3 (P3-001 ถึง P3-200) สำหรับนักเรียนชั้นประถมศึกษาปีที่ 3
 - ❖ Level 4 (P4-001 ถึง P4-200) สำหรับนักเรียนชั้นประถมศึกษาปีที่ 4
 - ❖ Level 5 (P5-001 ถึง P5-200) สำหรับนักเรียนชั้นประถมศึกษาปีที่ 5
 - ♣ Level 6 (P6-001 ถึง P6-200) สำหรับนักเรียนชั้นประถมศึกษาปีที่ 6 หากนักเรียนยังไม่มีพื้นฐานสำหรับการทำแบบฝึกทักษะในระดับชั้นที่เรียน ครูอาจพิจารณาให้ นักเรียนทำแบบฝึกทักษะในระดับที่ตรงกับความสามารถของนักเรียน และสามารถนำแบบฝึก ทักษะภาษาอังกฤษไปใช้เป็นกิจกรรมเสริมเนื้อหาที่สอดคล้องกับบทเรียนได้ตามความเหมาะสม
- 2. ควรให้ผู้เรียนเริ่มทำแบบฝึกทักษะ เรียงลำดับตามหมายเลขแบบฝึก จาก 001 200 วันละ 1 ฉบับ เป็นอย่างน้อย
- 3. กำหนดเวลาในการทำแบบฝึกทักษะหลังชั่วโมงเรียนสุดท้ายของทุกวัน ประมาณ 10 15 นาที
- 4. ครูควรสังเกต กำกับ ดูแล ขณะนักเรียนทำแบบฝึกทักษะ เพื่อช่วยเหลือให้คำแนะนำ
- 5. ครูควรตรวจแบบฝึกทักษะของนักเรียนทุกคน เมื่อนักเรียนทำเสร็จทุกวัน เพื่อประเมินว่า นักเรียนควรผ่านหรือควรฝึกซ้ำ พร้อมลงบันทึกในสมุดบันทึกแบบฝึกทักษะตามเกณฑ์ดังนี้

 - 💠 การทำแบบฝึกทักษะที่มีคำตอบถูกผิด นักเรียนควรผ่านเกณฑ์ร้อยละ 60 ขึ้นไป
- 6. ครูควรจัดหาสื่อที่ส่งเสริมและเอื้อต่อการทำแบบฝึกทักษะของนักเรียนให้เพียงพอต่อจำนวน นักเรียน เช่น หนังสือคลังคำศัพท์ เครื่องมือในการสืบค้นออนไลน์ เป็นต้น
- 7. ครูควรหาวิธีการเสริมแรง กระตุ้น สร้างแรงจูงใจในการทำแบบฝึกทักษะของผู้เรียน อย่างสม่ำเสมอ
- 8. ควรจัดหาแฟ้มสะสมผลงานการทำแบบฝึกทักษะสำหรับนักเรียนทุกคน เพื่อประเมิน ความสามารถของนักเรียนจากการทำแบบฝึกทักษะ และพัฒนานักเรียนได้อย่างต่อเนื่อง


